

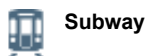
The MBTA is proud to host thousands of Marathon Day spectators and runners every year as they travel throughout Boston. To make traveling around the city easier on race day, there is a special Marathon viewing map with distances to the race course from transit stations and the MBTA is offering unlimited travel tickets for Marathon Day on the Framingham/Worcester Commuter Rail Line.

The Boston Marathon will be run on Monday, April 17, 2017, and before and after the race transit service will run on rush-hour schedules.

Pre-marathon activities are also

scheduled on Saturday, April 15, and Sunday, April 16 so the MBTA will be adjusting various bus routes in and around Copley Square to circumvent street closings. In addition, on Marathon Day, various bus routes will be detoured and Copley Square Station will be closed.

Due to an increase in customers using the MBTA on Marathon Day, bikes are not allowed on any MBTA vehicles on Monday, April 17. Please note, backpacks, coolers, cans, bottles and large items are not permitted at the marathon. We appreciate your cooperation and wish all runners a good day.



Temporary Green Line Station Closures (10 a.m. - approximately 6 p.m.)

For the safety of our customers, Copley Station will be closed for the entire day on April 17, 2017. Customers may use Arlington (all branches), Prudential (E Branch), or Hynes Convention Center (B, C, and D Branches) instead, or Back Bay on the Orange Line.

The following above-ground Green Line stations will be closed between 10 a.m. and approximately 6 p.m. on Marathon Monday:

- South Street (B Branch)
- Kent Street (C Branch)
- St. Mary's Street (C Branch)

The Red Line, Orange Line, and Blue Line, Green, and Silver Line will operate a regular weekday schedule with rush-hour levels of service before and after the race.



The Commuter Rail will operate a regular weekday schedule, with two additional trains on the Framingham/Worcester Line to support additional crowds. The schedules for these trains are below, and other Commuter Rail Schedules are available [here](#).

All bikes, including folding bikes, will be prohibited on-board trains on Monday, April 17. Additionally, bikes will not be permitted on the Framingham/Worcester Line on Sunday, April 16, after 8:00 p.m.

Bus

Several Marathon-related events will take place during the weekend prior to Marathon Monday, which will affect some bus routes. Bus routes affected by Marathon-related events are listed below.

Saturday, April 15, 2017

Boylston Street will be closed all day. Routes 9, 39, and 55 will be detoured from Boylston Street.

- Route 9
 - Will terminate at Back Bay Station at Dartmouth Street. There will be no service to Huntington Ave, Ring Road, Boylston Street, or Arlington Street, between Boylston and Stuart Streets. Bus stop connections can be made at Back Bay Station or Arlington and

Isabella Street.

- Route 39
 - Inbound connections can be made at Back Bay Station and Clarendon Street or Huntington and Mass Ave.
 - Outbound connections can be made at Back Bay Station or Huntington Ave and Evans Way.
- Route 55
 - Inbound: Will not serve Boylston Street between Dalton and Arlington Streets. Inbound bus stop connections can be made at Boylston and Saint Cecilia's Streets or at Saint James.
 - Outbound: Outbound service is not impacted and will run its regular route.

During the Boston Athletic Association 5K, some roads will be closed from approximately 5:00 am to 12:00 pm. The Route 43 will be detoured during this time.

- Route 43
 - Will terminate at Tremont and Stuart Streets from approximately 5 a.m. to 12 p.m. with no service to Charles Street, Charles Street South, Beacon Street, Park Street, Tremont Street, Park Street Station, or Boylston Street Station. Bus stop connections can be made at Tremont and Stuart Streets or at 285 Tremont Street.

Sunday, April 16, 2017

Boylston Street will be closed all day. Routes 9, 39, and 55 will be detoured from Boylston Street.

- Route 9
 - Will terminate at Back Bay Station at Dartmouth Street. There will be no service to Huntington Avenue, Ring Road, Boylston Street, or Arlington Street between Boylston and Stuart Streets. Bus stop connections can be made at Back Bay Station or Arlington and Isabella Streets.

- Route 39
 - Inbound bus stop connections can be made at Back Bay Station and Clarendon Street or Huntington and Massachusetts Avenues.
 - Outbound bus stop connections can be made at Back Bay Station and Clarendon Street or Huntington Avenue and Evans Way.

- Route 55
 - Inbound: Will not service Boylston Street between Dalton and Arlington Streets. Inbound bus stop connections can be made at Boylston and Saint Cecilia's Streets or at Saint James Avenue.
 - Outbound: Outbound service is not impacted and will run its regular route.

Monday, April 17, 2017 - Patriot's Day/Marathon Monday

Buses and trackless trolleys will operate a weekday schedule unless specifically noted below.

Some bus routes will be detoured due to the Marathon and other Patriots' Day race events. The approximate time for most street closures is 8 a.m. through 6:30 p.m.

There will be no bus service to Cleveland Circle Station (Green Line C branch), Reservoir Station (Green Line D branch), the Kenmore Square area, Brookline Avenue, Boylston Street, or the Copley Square area. There will be no service to Huntington Avenue (westbound/outbound) from St. James Street to Massachusetts Avenue. From the start of service until approximately 10:30 a.m., there will be no service to Temple Place, Charles Street, Beacon Street, or Tremont Street (Boston Common).

The following routes will be rerouted at certain times during Marathon Monday to prevent disruption to the race or other Patriots' Day events:

- Route 8, 19, 60, and 65: During the Marathon, there is no service on Brookline Ave between Park Drive and Kenmore. Buses will terminate at Fenway Station (Green Line D branch) on Park Drive near the intersection with Boylston Street and Brookline Ave. Outbound connections can be made at Brookline Avenue and Pilgrim

Road. Inbound connections can be made at Brookline Avenue and Fenway.

- Routes 9 and 10: Buses terminate at Back Bay Station. Connections can be made at Back Bay Station on Dartmouth Street.
- Route 39: Omitting Copley Square for the entirety of Marathon Monday. Connections can be made on Clarendon Street.
- Route 43: Omitting Charles Street between the Public Garden and the Common. Connections can be made at the State Transportation Building.
- Route 47: Central Square, Cambridge to Albany Street. The Inbound trip terminates at Granite Street and Memorial Drive. The Outbound trip terminates at the Old Sears building. There will be no service between Brookline Avenue and the BU Bridge. Inbound connections can be made at Granite and Brookline in Cambridge. Outbound connections can be made at Brookline Avenue and the Fenway in Boston.
- Route 52: Service will run in two segments: Watertown Yard to Centre St. at Ward St. (just north of Commonwealth Ave) and Newton Center to Dedham Mall. There will be no service between Ward St. and Newton Center.
- Route 55: No service.
- Route 57: Buses will terminate at Commonwealth Ave and Blandford Street. There will be no service to Kenmore Station. Outbound connections can be made at Commonwealth Avenue and Sherborn Street. Inbound connections can be made at Commonwealth Avenue and Blandford Street.
- Route 59: Service will run in two segments: Watertown Sq. to Newtonville and Newton Highlands to Needham Junction. There will be no service on Walnut Street between Newton Highlands and Newtonville Avenue.
- Route 62 and 76: Due to the Patriots' Day Parade, the Lexington Center stop is omitted between 12 p.m. and 5 p.m.
- Route 66: Service will run in two segments: Harvard to Union Sq (Allston), and Brookline Village to Dudley. There will be no service on Harvard Street between Brookline Village and Union Square in Allston.
- Route 86: Buses will terminate at Chestnut Hill Ave at Winship St. There will be no service between Cleveland Circle/Reservoir and Chestnut Hill Avenue at Winship Street.
- Route 94, 95, 96, 101, and 134: Buses will be omitting the Medford Square area due to the Ride of Paul Revere Reenactment between 11:30 a.m. and approximately 12:30 p.m. Connections can be made at

Main Street at High Street or Winthrop at High Street.

- Route 502 and 503: No service.
- Route 504: There will be no service to Stuart Street or St. James Avenue. Inbound connections can be made at Kneeland Street and Washington Street. Outbound connections can be made at Back Bay Station on Dartmouth Street.



- All Ferry Service will operate a regular weekday schedule.
